International Conferences and Publications since 1994

1. EFCF Publication options

a. All contributions, which deliver an extended abstract, have the opportunity to be published with an own DOI in the EFCF community of the generalpurpose open-access repository www.Zenodo.org.



All one-page abstracts of the oral & poster presentations are published in the **Book of Abstracts**. Together with all ex-tended abstracts, they are made available in the electronic **Proceedings of the conference**. They are distributed to the EFCF participants only, as a temporary reference during the conference and as ongoing internal reference in the EFCF MemberZone. The **final EFCF Proceedings** will be a synthesis of the Book of Abstracts and the access info to the available, event related publications. It is freely accessible on www.EFCF.com/Proceedings together with all other event info.

This option is **STANDARD**, **if there is no information** or feedback from the authors.

b. Special Issue of FUEL CELLS - From Fundamentals to Systems Impact Factor 2019: 1.876, www.fuelcells.wiley-vch.de

The Scientific Advisory Board of the EFCF will select a limited number of contributions for inclusion in a Special Issue. The selected papers will need to comply with the Journal's guidelines, and go through the peer-review process.



Please **INFORM US**, **if you are interested** in being considered for the Special Issue. If your contribution is selected for publication, only Title, Authors and one-page abstract plus the Special Issue access info will remain in the in the final EFCF Proceedings (see 1.a.).

2. Publication ELSEWHERE

Some authors wish to publish their work elsewhere e.g. in another peer-reviewed journal, and therefore choose not to be included in the web publication of EFCF.

Please INFORM US, if you DO NOT WANT TO BE INCLUDED in the ISBN WEB PUBLICATION of EFCF (1.a.) or in the Special Issue (1.b.).

Title, Authors and a one-page Abstract with the note "Only the abstract is available, because the authors chose to publish elsewhere. Please see Presentations on www.efcf.com/LIB or contact the authors directly" will remain in the EFCF proceedings.

<u>For your information:</u> All author requests to re-use the results in another publication will be favourably answered by the EFCF, subject to citation.

Summary of publication options for all EFCF Authors: DOI (1.a.) = STANDARD, if there is no information/feedback from the authors. = Yes, I like to publish my contribution with an own DOI in the EFCF community of the open-access repository www.Zenodo.org FUEL CELLS/DOI (1.b.) = I am interested in the Special Issue of Fuel Cells - From Fundamentals to Systems. If not selected, the contribution shall be published with an own DOI (see 1.a.). ELSEWHERE (2.) = I would like to publish ELSWHERE. If known I will deliver the access info to my publications, which can be added in the final EFCF Proceedings with only the one page abstracts plus the access info.
