

Your Activities in Lucerne

During the European Full Cell forum you have the possibility to explore the beautiful region of Lucerne together with an experienced local guide. You may book below tours via Bucher Travel Lucerne. Please note that the tours to Mount Pilatus and Mount Stanserhorn only take place with a minimum of 5 participants.

WEDNESDAY JULY 2, MOUNT PILATUS

Exciting trip to Mount Pilatus – 2133m (7,000ft) above sea level! After a leisurely train ride to Alpnachstad ascend by the steepest cogwheel train in the world to Pilatus Kulm. On top you have time to walk up to the vista point. Enjoy fresh air and admire the breath-taking panorama over the Swiss Alps and Lucerne with its lake. Then descend by aerial cable car to Fräkmüntegg, change to gondola cars which sweep you over pine forests and mountain meadows to the village of Kriens. Return by public bus to Lucerne.

11:30am (approx.) descend by aerial cable car via Fräkmüntegg to Kriens and public bus to Lucerne
01:00pm latest arrival back in Lucerne

THURSDAY JULY 3, GLASS FACTORY & MOUNT STANSERHORN

The glassworks at Hergiswil has existed since 1817. The tour starts in the permanent exhibition of the history of glass and glassworks. This labyrinth of scenes leads you through the ups and downs of the 180 years history of the glass factory and directly to the incandescent glass furnace. With a good view to the glass makers' platform, you can observe the craftsmen as they go about their rhythmical work and discover for yourself how glass is formed, blown and cast from the glowing mass. Discover and learn about glass in the exhibition – a stimulating journey of experience through the world of glass. Or let you enchant in Switzerland's only glass labyrinth which opened in June 2010. The entire range, from both the Roberto Niederer and the "Glasi Hergiswil" collections, is on display here. Glassware with minor imperfections also has a certain appeal. Glass in its perfect form, wrapped as a precious gift, can be purchased in the 1st quality shop. Continue again by train to Stans for an exciting trip to Mount Stanserhorn.

First you cross the meadows in the romantic, original Old-time funicular from 1893 with fringed curtains. After an exciting ten minute ride you change over to the world's first open deck aerial cable, which takes you in another ten minute to the 1,900m peak of Mount Stanserhorn.

Waltzing around the Alps... Warning: a trip to the revolving Restaurant Rondorama could be addictive! The glorious views of Eiger, Moench and Jungfrau, ten lakes and 100km of alpine vistas, not to speak of the fresh alpine air and the delicious food - you will want to come back here again and again! Return to Lucerne by train.

02:00pm descend back to Stans and continuation by train to Lucerne
03:30pm back in Lucerne

FRIDAY JULY 4, CITY TOUR OF LUCERNE

You will learn important, humorous and interesting facts about Lucerne's history, churches, bridges, narrow streets, towers, squares and, of course, Lucerne's trademark - the Chapel Bridge with Water Tower. During your sightseeing you will be shown the most important sights as:

- 14th century Chapel Bridge with its Water Tower, part of the city's fortifications and Europe's oldest covered wooden bridge
- Baroque Jesuit Church
- Franciscan Church from the 14th century
- Spreuer Bridge with its 'Dance of Death' paintings
- Musegg Wall, rampart walls built in 1386
- Old City Squares with historical buildings
- Town Hall in Italian Renaissance style with open arcades facing the River Reuss
- Hof Church, the main Cathedral and also the most important Renaissance Church in Switzerland
- Lion Monument, memorializing the Swiss Guards who defended the Royal Palace in Versailles during the French Revolution
- KKL – Lucerne's Culture and Convention Center of the Parisian architect Jean Nouvel
